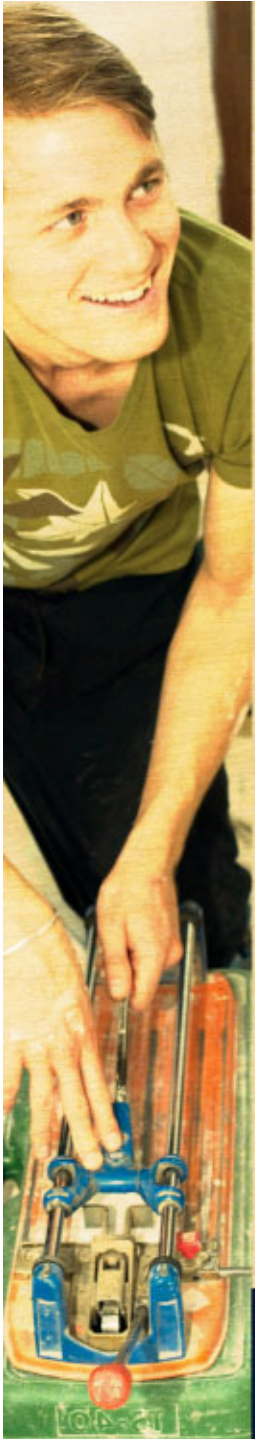

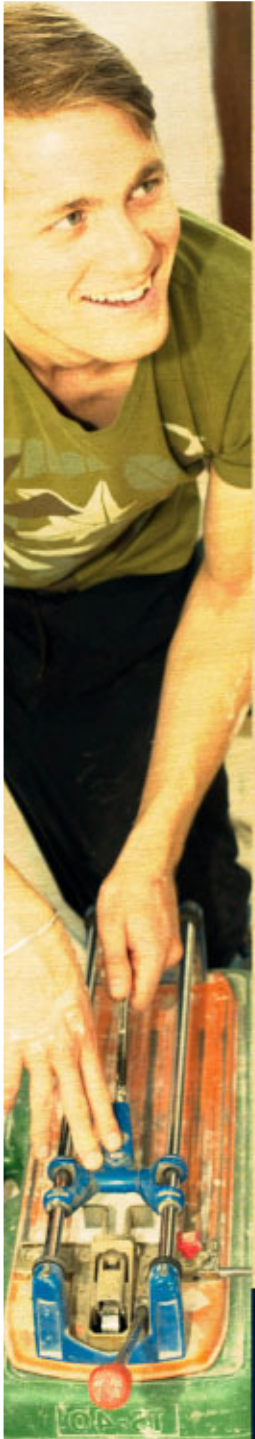

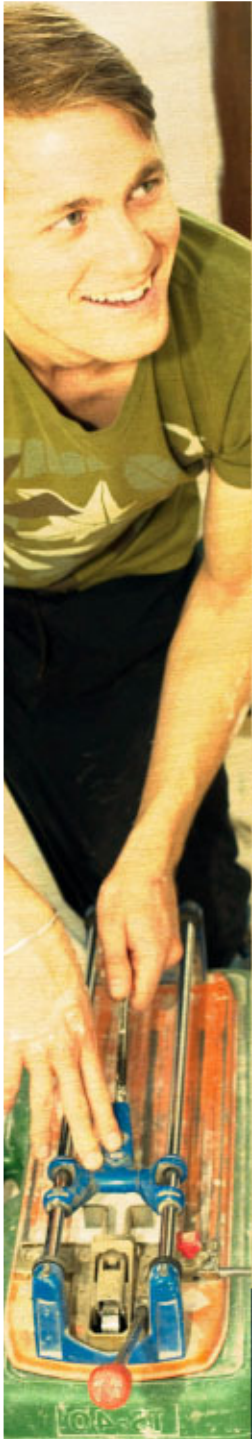
Qualifications' Landscape

- Proposed new qualification landscape submitted to NZQA in May 2013

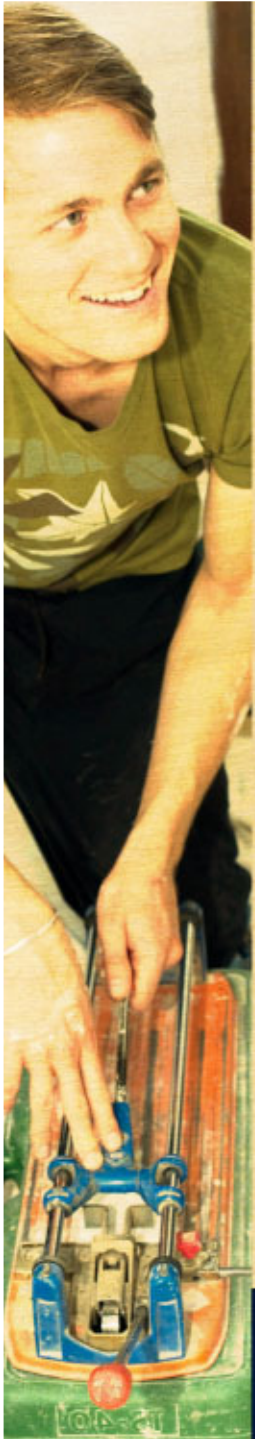

- Approval (August / September 2013) given for the development of 34 qualifications

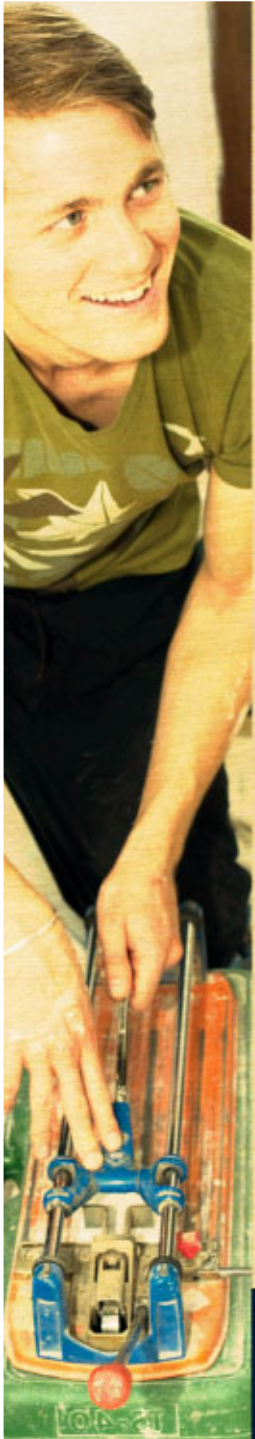

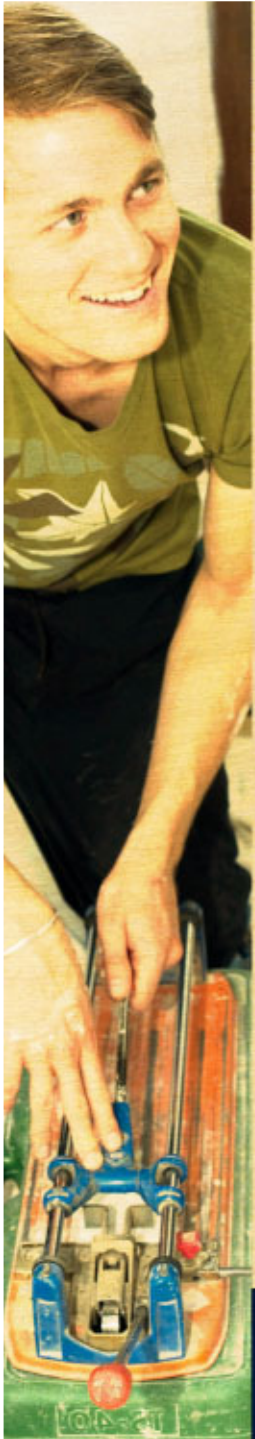
NZ Certificate in Construction Trades (Main Contract Supervision) L5

- Support Structures
- Frames and structures
- Exterior envelope
- Interior lining and finishing

Each specification has skills sets comprising of;

Know (theory) Do (practical) Comments (specific aspects of knowledge and skills)

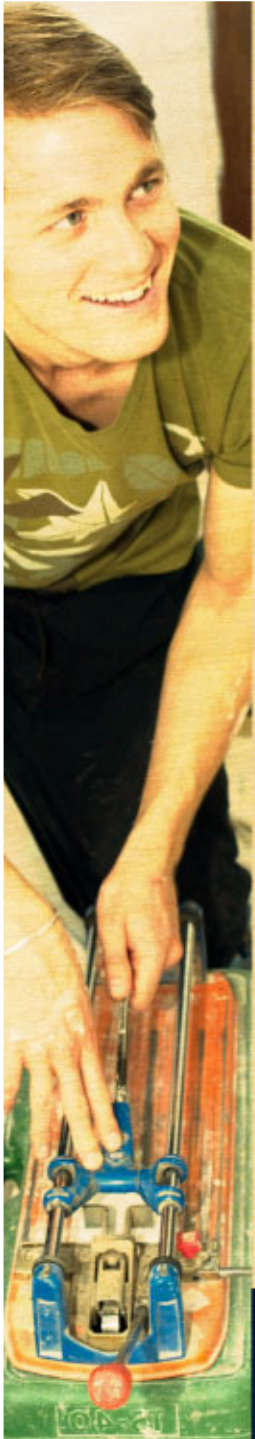


Consultation / Approval
